**Please Note:** If you seek **initial** treatment from the Emergency Room, Urgent Care or other provider, you will need to provide them with your claim billing information; otherwise, you will be billed. The payment of bills outside of an authorized provider will be dependent on your claim being compensable. One of the medical providers designated above must provide all follow-up care. If follow-up care is with an *unauthorized* medical provider, the employee will be responsible for payment for said treatment(s) and related cost.
